TREE BREWING Raspberry Porter

\$6.25 - Kelowna, British Columbia 5.0%

A robust porter with a raspberry kick

FERNIE BREWING What the Huck Huckleberry Wheat

\$6.00 - Fernie, British Columbia 5.0%

A touch of huckleberries blended with wheat. Smooth and creamy.

STORM BREWING Basil IPA

\$6.25 - Vancouver, British Columbia 7.0%

Storm's Hurricane IPA "dry hopped" with fresh basil

TIN WHISTLE BREWING CO. Peaches 'N Cream Okanagan Fruit Ale

A light amber, slightly hazy beer made with peach and apricot

RED TRUCK Limited Purple Haze Blueberry Blonde Ale

Deep purple in colour with a pinkish head, light blueberry aroma and tartness plus a dry finish

LOST COAST BREWERY Tangerine Wheat Ale

A refreshing wheat ale brewed with natural tangerine flavours

HOWE SOUND BREWING King Heffy

\$6.25 - Squamish, British Columbia 7.7%

A modern, high-alcohol twist on the classic unfiltered German hefe

PYRAMID BREWERIES Audacious Apricot Ale

\$7.00 - Seattle, Washington 5.1%

Combines fresh apricot with the smooth finish of wheat malt

CENTRAL CITY BREWING Raspberry Wheat Ale

LAGERS & PILSNERS

Made by bottom-fermenting yeast at colder temperatures, lagers are characteristically smooth, elegant, crisp and clean. Pilsner is a style of lager made famous in Pilsen, Czechoslovakia that is hoppier than your standard lager.

GRANVILLE ISLAND BREWING Honey Lager

Lightly hopped, mild and bright, with pure Fraser Valley honey

PHILLIPS BREWING Phoenix Gold Lager

Classic Bohemian lager liberally hopped with innovative varieties

VAN. ISLAND BREWING Hermann's Dark Lager

\$6.00 - Victoria, British Columbia 5.0%

Hermann's Dark Lager is a full bodied lager. A toasty malt nose with similar flavors on the palate and a somewhat nutty character.

PALE ALES & IPA'S

Pale Ales are brewed with pale malts and are generally lighter in style than regular (bitter) ales. India Pale Ales are a style that originated in Britain in the 19th century. IPA's were high in alcohol as well as hops, which allowed them to survive the very long two month sea voyage to British troops serving in India.

LONGWOOD BREW PUB Altbier

\$6.00 - Nanaimo, British Columbia 5.5%

A German-style ale fermented at lager temperatures yielding a cleaner, crisper beer than your average ale.

OLD YALE BREWING CO Pale Ale

DRIFTWOOD BREWERY Farmhand Ale

A traditional Belgian-style Saison brewed with fresh cracked black pepper

BROWN, AMBER & CREAM ALES

A reddish-brown ale made with dark or brown malt. Typically rich without being filling, displaying hints of chocolate and fruity sweetness with varying degrees of bitterness. Known in England as a “thirst-quencher”.

CANNERY BREWING Naramata Nut Brown

\$6.00 - Penticton, British Columbia 5.5%

A full bodied ale with a rich and gentle flavour

CRANNOG ALES Bogtrotter Brown

\$6.00 - Sorrento, British Columbia 4.8%

100% Organic. A big roasty, delicious brown ale. Nicely rounded with lots of maltiness

RUSSELL BREWING Cream Ale

\$5.50 - Surrey, British Columbia 5.0%

Full-bodied with an easy, creamy, smooth finish

WHEAT BEERS

Generally light in hops and heavy in carbonation, wheat ales are made from wheat, instead of barley, by top fermentation. Wheat ales are unfiltered, usually very pale and cloudy in appearance, and effervescent on the nose.

DRIFTWOOD BREWERY White Bark Ale

\$5.50 - Victoria, British Columbia 5.5%

Traditional Belgian-style wheat ale is brewed with the addition of freshly ground coriander and curacao orange peel

STOUTS

Stouts, the darkest of beers, are made with highly roasted malts, barley, and differentiated by their deep brown-black colour, chocolate and coffee flavours, and fuller body.

ST. AUGUSTINE'S Stout

\$5.50 - Victoria, British Columbia 5.0%

An Irish-style black ale. This authentic full-flavoured ale is brewed to a clean, roasty finish with a smooth and malty character

CRANNOG ALES Backhand of God Stout

\$6.00 - Sorrento, British Columbia 5.2%

100% Organic. Lean in body and powerful in flavor, this dry stout is easy to drink, rich, and inviting. It is extraordinarily smooth and mildly hopped with a distinct coffee/chocolate presence

PIKE BREWING COMPANY XXXXX Stout

\$7.00 - Seattle, Washington 7.0%

Full-bodied velvety malt texture with hints of chocolate, licorice, and espresso on the palate

LONGWOOD BREW PUB Russian Imperial Stout

\$6.25 - Nanaimo, British Columbia 6.5%

A combination of roasted barley, chocolate and black barley gives this beer a rich complex malty flavour

CIDER

Made from the fermented juices of apples and other fruit, cider is crisp, easy-drinking, and refreshing.

MERRIDALE ESTATE CIDERY House Cider

\$6.75 - Cobble Hill, British Columbia 6.9%

Light, dry and effervescent and made with locally grown apples

LAMBIC

Unlike conventional beers which are fermented by carefully cultivated strains of brewer's yeasts, lambic beer is instead produced by exposing it to wild yeasts which gives the beer its distinctive flavour: dry, vinous, and cidery, with a slightly sour aftertaste.

STORM BREWING 12 Year Black Currant Lambic

\$6.75 - 10 oz. - Vancouver, British Columbia 7.0%

Not for the timid! This beer is INTENSELY sour, dry, and complex
